## ABOUT THE HOSTS

Demolition City Roller Derby (DCRD) was founded as an LLC in 2007 and we hosted our first official bout in 2008. DCRD was one of the first 10 leagues in the country to be accepted into the WFTDA Apprentice Program in September of 2009, and we were mentored by our sister league, the Naptown Rollergirls. DCRD became a full member of the WFTDA in June of 2010. We are composed of two travel teams, the Dynamite Dolls (charter / "A" team) and the Destruction Dames ("B" Team). DCRD has filed for 501C3 status and we are awaiting the official response from the government.

Our commitment to training hard and playing harder is matched only by our dedication to supporting local charities and community service organizations. We give from the heart. From the very beginning, DCRD has given back to our community by making contributions, promoting public awareness, and volunteering our services to local charities and organizations. We are proud of the positive impact we have made and are always looking for new opportunities to give back to the community.

The home venue for DCRD is the Soldiers and Sailors Memorial Coliseum. It is listed on the National Registrar of Historic Places and was built in 1916 to honor the local veterans who fought in the Civil War and Spanish-American War. It still maintains much of its historic details. Many well-known entertainers, including Johnny Cash, The Steve Miller Band, and Molly Hatchet, have performed there. It even hosted previous incarnations of roller derby.

DCRD has been voted the #1 sporting event in Evansville in the Courier and Press (our local newspaper) Reader's Choice awards for 2009, 2010, and 2011. The local hockey team has nudged us out of the top spot since their move to the Ford Center, but DCRD still does well in the voting each year.

## HOW TO GET HERE

### BY AIR

Evansville Regional Airport (EVV) is serviced by American Air Lines, US Airways, and Delta with hubs in Chicago, Dallas, Atlanta, and Detroit giving access to hundreds of cities world-wide.

Evansville is an approximate 2-hour drive away from three different international airports: St Louis (STL), Louisville (SDF), and Nashville (BNA); and it is approximately a three-hour drive from the international airport in Indianapolis (IND).

### BY BUS

The Greyhound station is located downtown at 119 NW 6th St which is just 1.5 blocks from the Ford Center and 8 blocks from the hotel.

### BY CAR

#### FROM I-164

Head south on I-164 S. Take exit 9 for IN-62/W Morgan Ave. Turn right onto IN-62/W Morgan Ave. Turn left onto US-41S and travel 3.9 miles. Turn right onto E Walnut St and travel 1.3 miles. Turn right onto SE MKL Jr Blvd and travel 1.3 miles. The Ford Center is 0.1 miles on the left.

#### FROM I-64

Take the 164 S Evansville Exit. Head south on I-164 S. Take exit 9 for IN-62/W Morgan Ave. Turn right onto IN-62/W Morgan Ave. Turn left onto US-41S and travel 3.9 miles. Turn right onto E Walnut St and travel 1.3 miles. Turn right onto SE MKL Jr Blvd and travel 1.3 miles. The Ford Center is 0.1 miles on the left.

### FROM HENDERSON

#### AND LOCATIONS SOUTH OF EVANSVILLE

Merge onto US-41N via the ramp to Evansville. Travel 5.8 miles. Take the ramp to Southlane Dr/Veterans Memorial Parkway. Travel 0.3 miles. Keep left at the fork to continue toward Southlane Dr/Veterans Memorial Parkway. Travel 3.0 miles. Slight left one SE Riverside Dr. Travel 0.2 miles. Turn right onto Walnut St and travel 0.5 miles. Turn left onto SE 7th St /MLK Jr Blvd and travel 0.1 miles. Ford Center is on the left.

## HOW TO GET TO THE HOTEL

The Tropicana Evansville is located at 421 NW Riverside Dr, which is about 8 blocks from the Ford Center. The parking garage is accessed from NW 1st St.

### FROM THE FORD CENTER

Head southeast on SE Martin Luther King Jr Blvd toward Locust St for 0.1 miles. Take the 1st right onto Walnut St. Travel 0.3 miles. Turn right onto SE 2nd St. Travel 0.3 miles. Turn left onto Court St. Take the 1st right onto NW 1st St. The entrance to the parking garage will be on your left.

## AROUND TOWN

There is one 18-passenger shuttle available at the hotel that can provide transportation to and from both the airport and the venue. Please make arrangements in advance as the space is limited.

Located in Evansville, Indiana, the Ford Center is a beautiful, exciting, multi-purpose 11,000-seat arena and is the region's center for sports and entertainment. The 290,000 square foot facility is home of the NCAA Division I University of Evansville Aces Men's and Women's basketball and the East Coast Hockey League Evansville IceMen. The arena floor has over 20,000 square feet of usable space and can be modified for basketball, hockey, concerts, conventions, rodeos, expos and a variety of other events.

## PARKING

Downtown Evansville features ample parking, including more than 1,500 spaces in city-owned parking garages on Locust St, Third St, and Sycamore St. Parking in the city-owned garages will be \$5 during events at the Ford Center. Integra Bank, 420 Main Building, Fifth Third Bank, and Old National also have parking garages Downtown. The lot behind the Civic Center contains more than 1,100 parking spaces, which will be free during events at the Ford Center.

Given that disability parking will be designated and the Ford Center will be conveniently located only one block from the METS transfer terminal, finding parking and getting to and from an event at the Ford Center in Downtown Evansville should not pose any undue problems for guests.

## SECURITY

There will be hired security personnel and volunteer security staff from DCRD to attend to crowd control and general security matters. You are advised not to leave valuables unattended as neither the WFTDA, DCRD, nor the The Ford Center will be responsible for loss, damage, or theft of your belongings. Any property you bring to the event is at your own risk.

## FOOD AND BEVERAGE

No outside food or beverage is allowed in the venue.



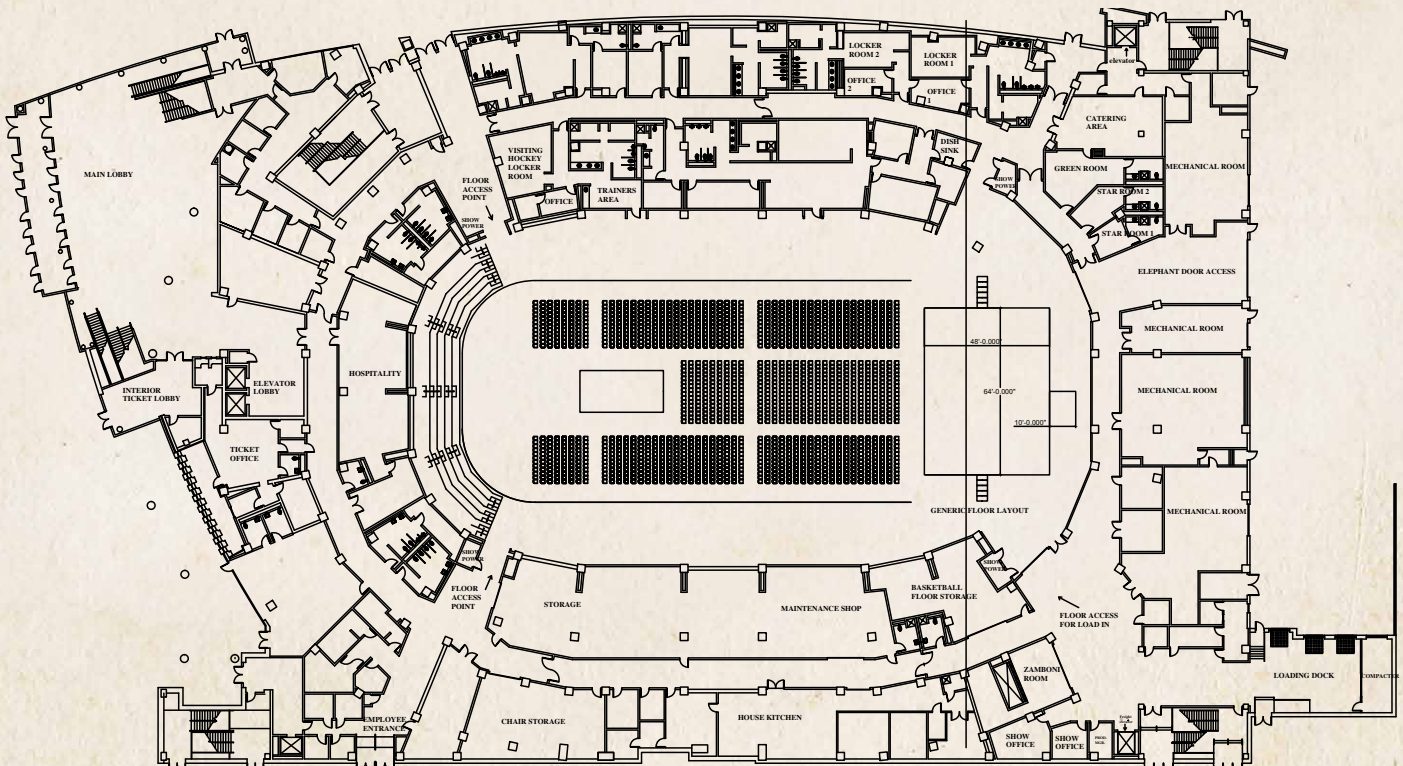

## NOTES AND ADDITIONAL FEES

- Discounts for active military personnel are available in person wherever tickets are sold.
- Children 8 years old and younger are always free with a ticketed and supervising adult! While admission is free for children under 8 years old, a child ticket will be required upon entry to track venue capacity, so please be sure to obtain one from the ticketing site.

## SEATING INFORMATION

- Seating is on a first come, first served basis. There will be bleachers, track-side floor seating, limited chair seating, and standing room sections. No reserved seating or VIP seating is offered for this tournament.
- No carry-in chairs are permitted near the track.
- In order to sit trackside, you must be at least 18 years old. If you do not have a valid photo ID to verify your age, you will be required to move.
- We expect high attendance at the tournament and seating areas to be full. Do not "save seats" for individuals who are not returning to their seats momentarily. You will be asked to remove skate bags, backpacks and other large items from the seating area in order to make room to accommodate others. Participant bags may be left in the participant-only area (locker rooms). Please be considerate and allow others to sit if a seat is not actively being occupied.

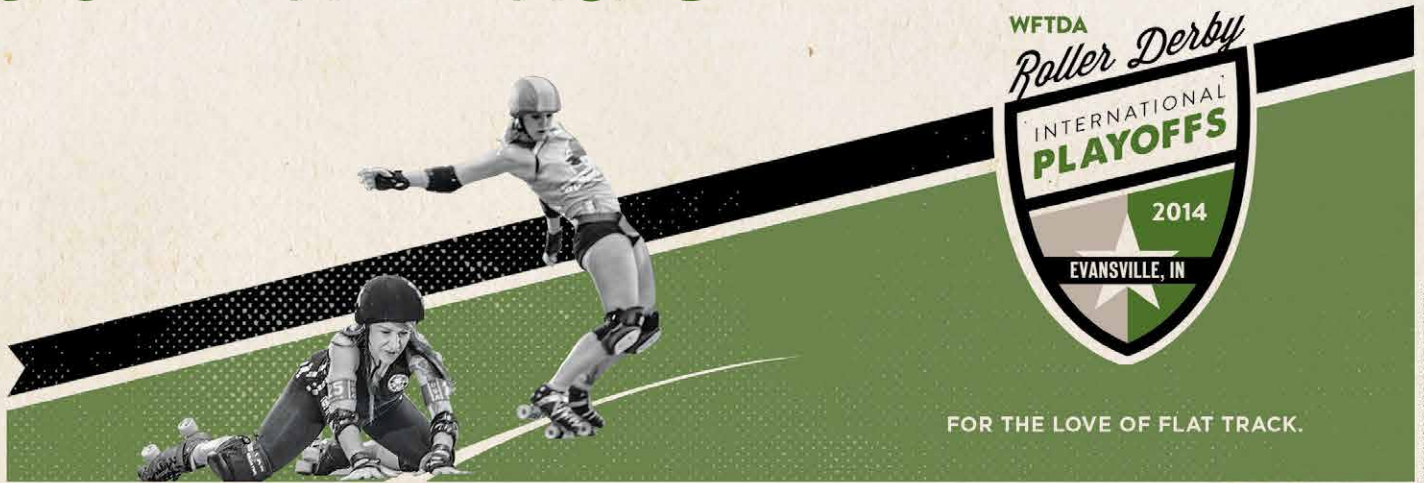
**Doors open daily at 9:30 AM. / Games begin at 10:00 AM.**

# SIGN IN AND LACE UP



## REGISTRATION

Registration will be held on Thursday, at the Tropicana Evansville, from 5:30 PM to 10:00 PM, at which time skaters, officials, and other credentialed participants will complete required paperwork and receive their tournament credentials.

Captains Meeting will be at the Tropicana Evansville on Thursday at 8:00 PM local time (US Central). Officials Meeting will be at the Tropicana Evansville on Thursday at 9:00 PM local time (US Central).

Credentials must be worn at all times in order to obtain access to the venue and to participant-only areas. There is a \$30 fee to replace lost or stolen credentials.

## TRACK FLOOR, WARM-UP SPACE, AND WARM-UP TIMES

The arena floor is polished concrete, built in 2011 so it will still be fairly slick. The venue is climate controlled which will maintain the cool, slickness of the floor. This is not Demolition City's home venue for their bouts, so they are not as familiar with what types of wheels work best. Come prepared with a few wheels to try.

The venue will be open by 8:00 AM Friday morning for skaters and officials who wish to test the floor.

The regulation track takes up most of the arena floor so there will be little-to-no additional warm-up space on the arena floor aside from the actual track. Teams will be allowed to warm up on the actual track during the half-time of the game prior to their own, as well as in the 20-30 minutes before the start of their bout.

## MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

The WFTDA Emergency Action Plan requires the WFTDA, as tournament host, to provide trained, certified emergency medical responders should an injury occur on the track. Only the WFTDA-provided EMTs may go onto the track or players benches to access or treat a skater or official. Once removed from the playing area, if the skater or official wishes to use their own medical provider, s/he may refuse additional treatment.

## TEAM ROOMS

There are several built-in locker room areas and these will be assigned based on the tournament schedule. Please note these rooms will be shared by all teams. Please leave the team rooms in better condition than you found them.

There will be designated areas to leave your gear when not assigned a locker room and these will be in credential-only areas. The Memorial Coliseum, the WFTDA and Demolition City Roller Derby assume no responsibility for items left unattended.



# WFTDA RULES



## WFTDA TOURNAMENT RULES

- No video or audio recording devices or cameras with detachable lenses without prior approval from the WFTDA. Please visit [wftda.com/tournaments/credentials](http://wftda.com/tournaments/credentials) for more information. **Deadline for applying for photographer credentials is August 21, 2014.**
- If you choose to sit trackside, you accept all responsibility for the possible risk of injury to you, or damage and/or destruction to your belongings at any time without warning. Trackside seating is at your own risk.
- You must remain seated in the trackside seating area. Keep your hands, feet, and belongings behind the safety line at all times. Do not touch or grab skaters or officials who fall into trackside seating. If a piece of clothing or equipment shall fall onto the track, do not enter the track or safety lane to retrieve it.
- Fire lanes, exits, and walkways must remain clear.
- Certain areas of the track and venue are reserved for individuals who require special seating or perform specific bout duties. They may obstruct the view of persons behind them. However, they are not able to move, sit, squat, or otherwise alter their position lest they not be able to complete their job function.
- By entering the venue, you agree to the possibility of being photographed, filmed or recorded. Your voice, image and likeness may be captured and recorded in and around the venue and publicly disseminated by any means and in any format or media. You waive all rights on an irrevocable, worldwide, perpetual basis to object to such recording and dissemination.

## GUEST CODE OF CONDUCT

The Women's Flat Track Derby Association strives to provide a safe and satisfying event for everyone in attendance by seeking your compliance with our guest code of conduct. We ask for your assistance in creating an environment that is free of:

- Abusive or foul language and obscene gestures directed toward other guests, venue employees, tournament staff and volunteers, players, coaches, and officials.
- Guests who are disruptive to the event or impair other guests' enjoyment.
- Intoxicated or drug-impaired individuals.
- Smoking, except in designated areas (located outside of the arena).
- Prohibited entry items such as outside food & beverage, weapons, non-service animals, air horns, vuvuzelas, megaphones, and laser pointers.
- Professional cameras, video cameras, and audio recorders are prohibited without prior authorization and proper credentials.
- Guests without proper authorization or credentials entering or attempting to enter restricted areas.
- Banners or signs that obstruct the view of guests, obscure sponsor advertising, contain objectionable subject matter, or are commercial in nature. The WFTDA and the venue reserve the right to remove any banner or sign at any time.

Guests not abiding by this Guest Code of Conduct are subject to ejection from the venue. In the event that you are refused entry into or requested to leave the venue for failure to comply with the Guest Code of Conduct or follow the venue regulations, you will not be entitled to a replacement or refund for your ticket. ## EVANSVILLE MUSEUM OF ARTS, HISTORY & SCIENCE

The Evansville Museum of Arts, History & Science is one of Southwestern Indiana's most established cultural institutions. This general museum maintains a permanent collection of more than 30,000 objects, including fine and decorative arts and historic, anthropological, and natural history artifacts. Over twenty temporary exhibitions are displayed every year in four changing galleries. Shows range from regional to internationally traveling exhibitions.

The Museum's new Koch Immersive Theater uses the newest in planetarium technology. The theater houses a 40-foot diameter domed screen with 360-degree digital projection and a 10,000-watt surround sound system. Programming for the Koch Immersive Theater is not be limited to astronomy programs but covers a broad range of science topics. The digital dome technology is a breakthrough experience known in the planetarium industry as a "full-dome" or "immersive" experience. The Theater utilizes two bright, digital video projectors, a huge 40-foot wide hemispherical projection screen and stadium-style seating to allow for great views from any seat.

Also on the museum's campus is the Evansville Museum Transportation Center (EMTRAC) featuring Southern Indiana transportation artifacts from the late 19th through the mid-20th centuries. On exhibit is a train that provides visitors with an opportunity to examine the exterior and interior of three historic railroad cars - a 1908 0-6-0 steam switch engine, a fully equipped 1926 club car, and a circa 1900 caboose. The museum is home to a variety of historic vehicles and a model train diorama of Evansville.

## LST 325

840 LST Dr, Along Riverfront at Marina Point  
Called the ship that won the war by Churchill, the LSTs were essential in sea-to-land invasions and many were built in Evansville. The 325 is 328 ft long, 50 ft wide, and 1,625 tons of steel power. This floating piece of history was on site in Normandy on D-Day. She is also the "Last of the Class," meaning she is the only operational LST in existence. Tours are led by dedicated and learned crewmembers, some who served on LSTs. The 325 occasionally leaves port for cruises on other waterways. Call for hours and special group rates.

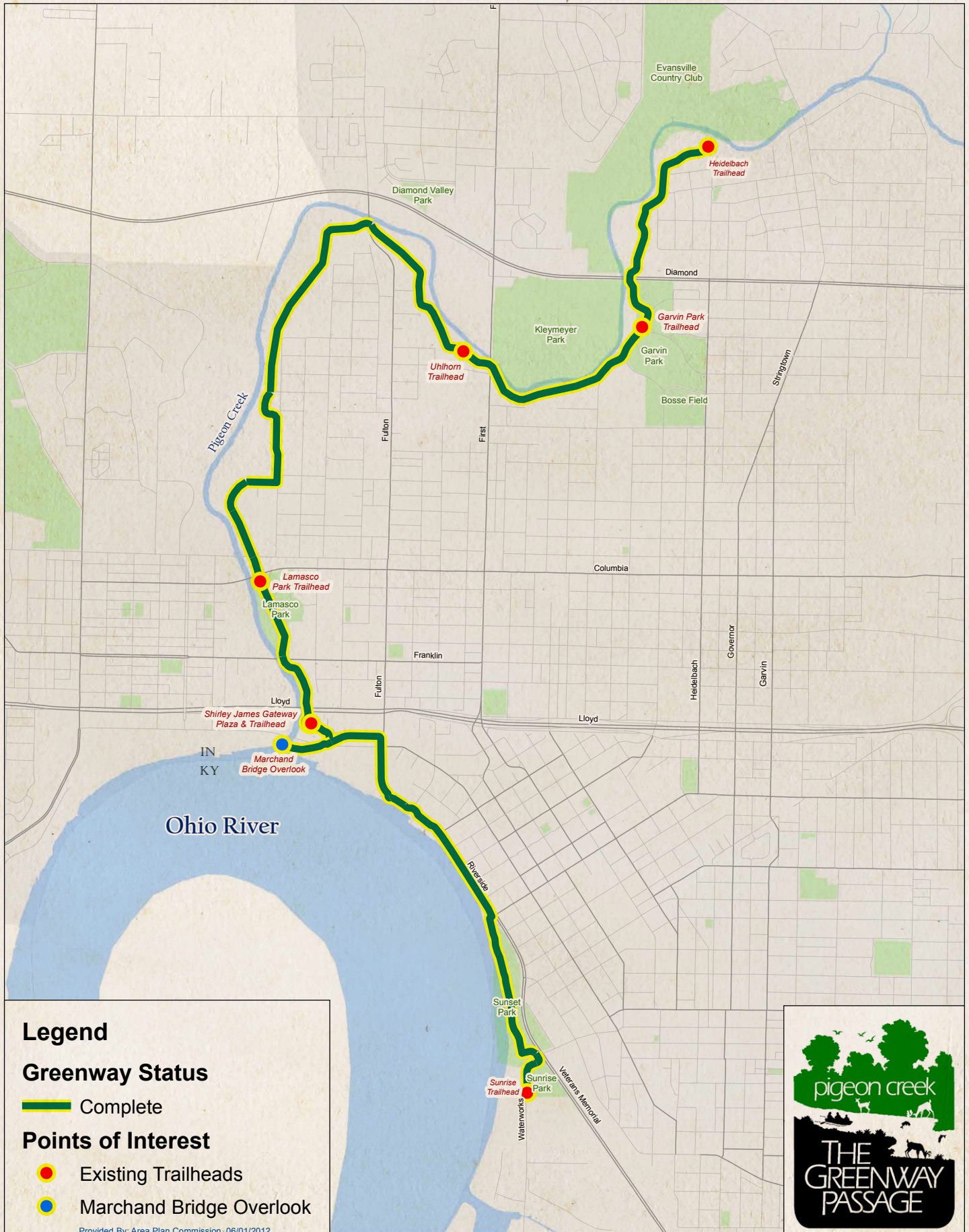

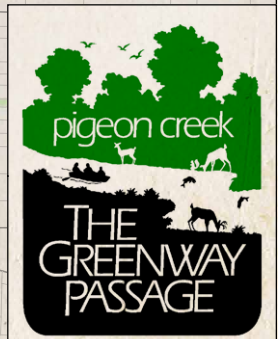

# GREENWAY MAP



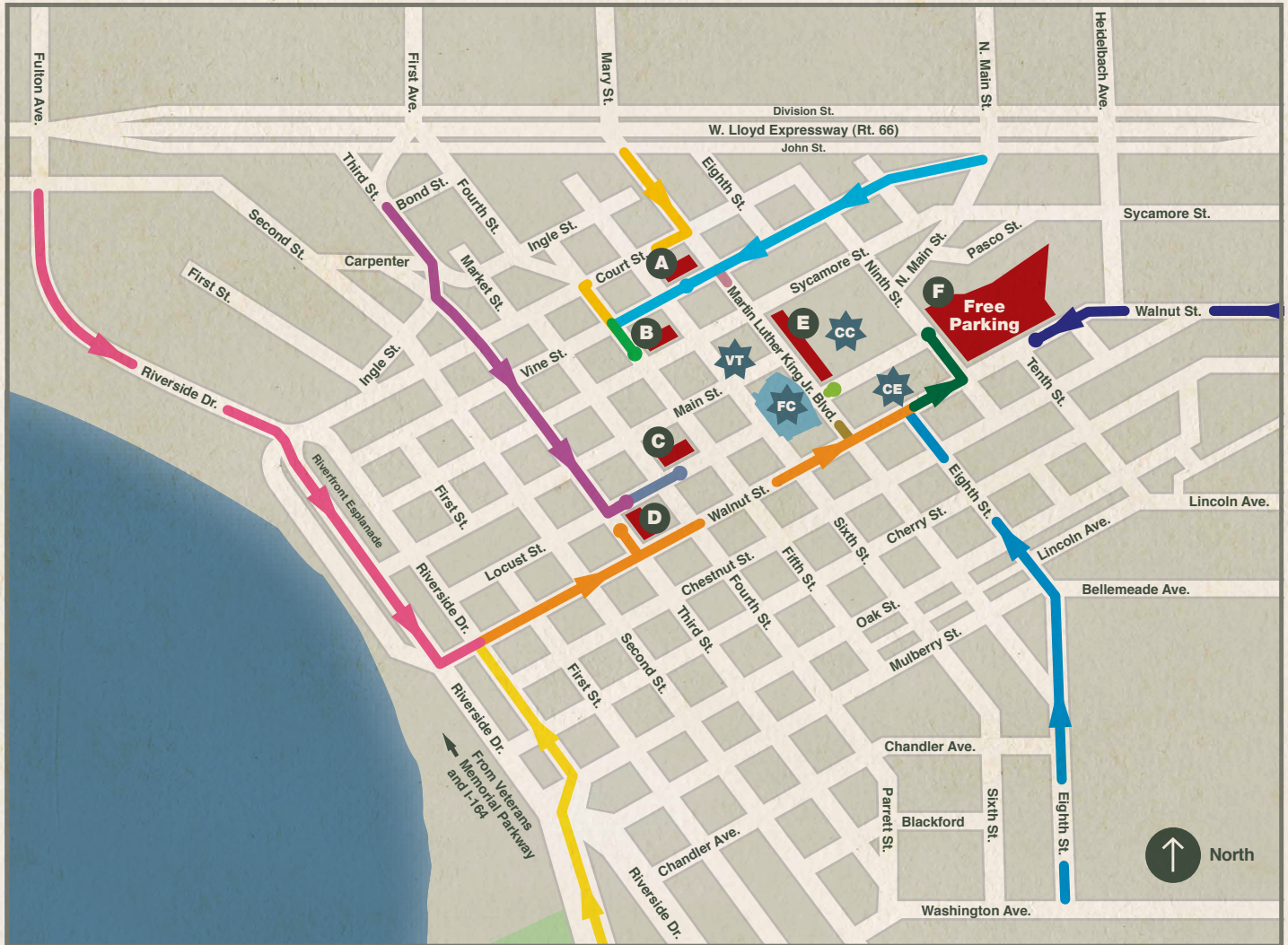

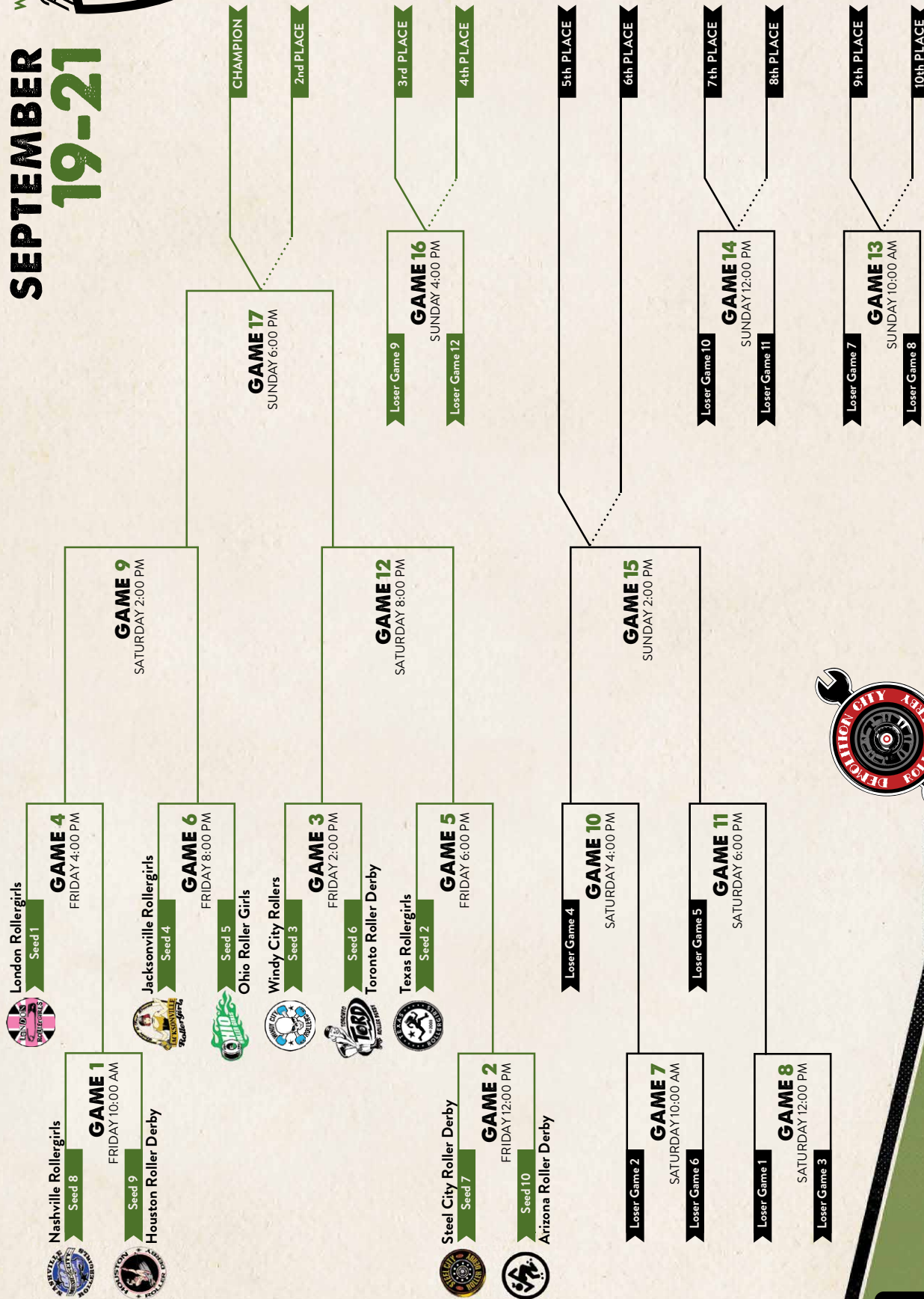
